Interviewer: Hello, I’m Tom Williams. We are very lucky to have Denise Evans here in the studio with us. Can you tell us about your company, Denise?

Denise [female]: Yes, my company is a small pioneering water charity set up in London– it’s called *True Water*. We support sustainable clean water projects in developing countries across the world.

Interviewer: What made you set up the company?

Denise: Well, I travelled in India in 2005 and ended up in hospital with a very nasty case of dysentery after drinking dirty water there.

Interviewer: How does that link to your company?

Denise: Bottled water sales have increased dramatically in the UK over the last few years and the profits from these sales go into the pockets of rich businessmen. My idea was to set up a company producing bottled water whose profits from sales would fund ethical clean water projects in India and other parts of the world.

Interviewer: What would you say the aims of your company are?

Denise: We want to be honest about global water problem issues. Six thousand children die each day across the world from a lack of clean water, so it’s clear that help is urgently needed.

Interviewer: Absolutely. Could you tell us a little about your charitable projects?

Denise: Essentially, we fund facilities that use the most effective water filtering process in the world. The facilities are owned and run by the local community and the idea is that they last long into the future. So far, we’ve funded fifteen projects in India with many more under way and we’ve helped over 100 000 people.

Interviewer: What does it cost to set up a project?

Denise: We need around 7 000 pounds for each project, which then provides clean safe drinking water for up to 7 000 people in the village and surrounding communities.

Interviewer: Who continues to manage the project?

Denise: Once a project is set up, it is maintained in the local area with support workers on hand. *True Water* staff make yearly visits to the villages to ensure the projects are being run properly, but really, we want to help people help themselves.

Interviewer: Oh, that's wonderful. Thank you very much.

Denise: Thank you.

При проверка на задачите с кратък свободен отговор не се вземат предвид правописни и граматически грешки. В отговора се оценява съответствието между информацията в него с тази в текста.

31. According to the author of the text, what is the key to participating in an adventure trip that involves camping?

The key to participating in an adventure trip that involves camping is your attitude to it (1 p.) rather than / and not having previous experience of it (1 p.).

32. Why should you check the comfort rating for the trip that you are thinking of going on?

You should check the comfort rating for the trip you are thinking of going on to make sure that the accommodation it offers suits you / is what you are looking for (2 p.)

33. What does the author of the text recommend to people who have decided to go on one of their adventure trips?

The author of the text recommends reading through the trip notes first / before going / before booking the trip (1 p.) and realistically self-assessing your physical ability / evaluating your own ability to complete the trip / if you'll be able to do it / to cope with the challenges (1 p.).

34. What are two things mentioned by the author of the text that can make some aspects of the trip more difficult?

The lack of the infrastructure [that tourists are used to] in the visited places (1 p.), and also the challenging / rough weather conditions [in some areas] (1p.) can make the trip more difficult.

35. What, in the context of this article, is a “kitty”?

A “kitty” is the group fund / money for common use for covering everyday purchases [of the group members in a more cost-effective way] (1 p.), [to which every member contributes at the start of the adventure tour] in addition to the trip price / not included in the trip price (1 p.).
