Teenagers' mental health is being damaged by a wide range of factors including heavy social media use, a new report has found. New research from the Education Policy Institute shows that the number of young people in England with mental health problems has risen to one in six, which is up from one in nine in 2017.

Using data from 5,000 young people in England, the researchers have found that wellbeing and self-esteem are similar in all children of primary school age, but by the age of 14, one in three girls is unhappy with their personal appearance, compared with one in seven at the end of primary school. The wellbeing of both genders falls during their teenage years, but girls experience a greater decline, the report says.

Heavy social media use is linked to negative wellbeing and self-esteem, as kids experiencing feelings of depression and hopelessness may turn to social media for comfort and community.

Lack of exercise is another contributing factor for poor mental health and wellbeing, the study finds. The problem has been made worse by the pandemic, as participation in activities and sports has fallen considerably due to school closures and lockdown.

The report makes several recommendations, including a £650 million package to schools for wellbeing funding and an increase in mental health teaching in schools. Young people are among the hardest hit by the COVID pandemic and lockdowns, so it is more important than ever that they can access support with their mental health during this critical time in their lives.

**Оценяване на задачите с кратък свободен отговор**

Въпросите от № 31 до № 35 са отворени. Задачите с кратък свободен отговор се оценяват с **0 точки, 1 точка** или **2 точки** в зависимост от верността и пълнотата на отговора. При проверка на задачите с кратък свободен отговор не се вземат предвид правописни и граматически грешки. В отговора се оценява съответствието между информацията в него с тази в текста.

**Отговорите на отворените въпроси са примерни.** Приема се за верен всеки отговор, формулиран по различен начин, но съответстващ на въпроса и на информацията.

**№ 31. Why is teen drama one of the most enduring TV genres?**

[Teen drama is one of the most enduring TV genre] because everyone's been a teenager (1 p.), and teenager experiences make [for] interesting stories (1 p.).

**№ 32. What four different types of conflict do teenagers face?**

[Teenagers may face/have to deal with] the ups and downs of friendships (0.5 p.), unstable intimate/romantic relationships (0.5 p.), conflicts with authoritative figures / outside pressure from peers, parents and other people (0.5 p.), or even the fate of the world (0.5 p.).

**№ 33. What are three sources of pressure experienced by teens?**

[Teenagers feel/experience] pressure by parents (0.5 p.), peers/other teenagers (0.5 p.) , society in general (1 p.).

**№ 34. What two disadvantages of controlling your own life does the text mention?**

[The disadvantages are] taking the wrong path / making a wrong decision (1 p.), making mistakes (1 p.).

**№ 35. Why does teen drama often place its characters in extreme or fantastical situations?**

[Teen drama places characters in extreme or fantastical situations] in order to heighten the viewers' emotional experience / to make it easier for the viewers to empathise with the characters. (2 p.).
